The Monitoring Team Members for Cold and Dry Storage Warehouses and/or production areas shall perform the following functions:

1. Document compliance with good agricultural practices, monitoring of pests and diseases, and compliance of Storage Warehouses with DA AC No. 1 Series of 2021, BPI AC No. 1 Series of 2021, and SPS regulations.
2. Monitors and validates the stock inventory of local produce and imported onion and garlic.
3. Coordinates with HVCDP, AMAS, DA-RE, DA-CA, CSWCT, LGUs, growers, and other stakeholders or agencies in the performance of these functions.
4. Submits weekly monitoring reports with documentation to the Secretariat.
5. Focal members must facilitate the rotation (within their scope of area) of the assigned members in every monitoring activity to be submitted to the Secretariat.
6. Shall perform other tasks given by the Chair through the Secretariat.
